Elks National Foundation (ENF) Scholarships

High school seniors, planning to attend college in 2018, should begin working on financial aid packages soon. The Elks National Foundation has three ways to assist our future leaders.

There are 500 four-year Most Valuable Student scholarships, ranging from \$1,000 to \$12,500/year. Applicants must be high school seniors, who are U.S. citizens, and intend to pursue a 4 year degree, on a full-time basis, at a U.S. institution. The application deadline is November 27, 2017.

There are 250 Legacy Awards (\$4,000 scholarships - \$1,000/year for four years) presented to children or grandchildren (including "steps") of Elk members. The application deadline is noon, Central time, on February 2, 2018.

Emergency Educational Grants, up to \$4,000, are available to full-time college students that are children (including "steps") of deceased or totally disabled Elk members. The application deadline is October 31, 2017.
